TRINITY WINS 11TH CONSECUTIVE TEAM TITLE; DOMINATES ALL-TOURNAMENT SELECTIONS

ATLANTA, Ga. - Trinity University clinched the 2004 SCAC Men's Tennis Tournament Championship with a 7-0 win over DePauw University at the Spring Sports Festival at Oglethorpe University. The victory gave the TU Tigers their 11th consecutive SCAC men's tennis championship and 12th overall.

The TU Tigers, who swept all three of their matches 7-0, dominated the all-tournament team field, earning spots for six individuals and three doubles teams.

With 3-0 records in the singles' competition, both J.D. Prichard of Hendrix College and Jordan Taillon of Trinity played their way onto the all-tournament team for a record third consecutive year.
