SCAC ANNOUNCES 2004 ALL-TOURNAMENT SOFTBALL TEAM

ATLANTA, Ga. – The two teams that met for the 2004 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference (SCAC) softball championship were rewarded with the most selections on the all-tournament team. Sewanee-University of the South won its first-ever conference softball title this past weekend and had three players selected to the team, while Millsaps College, last year’s champion, had four players named.

Senior shortstop Robin Rockco of Millsaps and senior pitcher Amy Owensby of Sewanee were selected to the team for the third consecutive year. Only Shannon George (1999, '00, '02) and Kyle Schumacher (1999, '00, '01) – both of Trinity University – have been three-time all-tournament honorees. Junior pitcher Tammy Ladner of Millsaps was selected to the team for the second consecutive year.
