**TRINITY WINS 13TH CONSECUTIVE TEAM TITLE;
SIX TIGERS EARN ALL-TOURNAMENT STATUS**

ATLANTA, Ga. - Trinity University clinched the SCAC Women's Tennis Championship with a 9-0 win over DePauw University this past Sunday at the 2004 Spring Sports Festival at Oglethorpe University.

The victory gave the TU Tigers their 13th consecutive SCAC women's tennis title.

Tara Kurtz of Southwestern University and Heather McGowan of Trinity earned their way onto the all-tournament team for a third-consecutive year, while Christy Austin of Trinity was a repeat on the team from a year ago.
