**TRINITY SELECTED TO REPEAT AS
SCAC VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONS**

The Trinity University Tigers have been selected to win their fifth-consecutive women's volleyball SCAC championship, based on exclusive voting by the head coaches in the conference. If the Tigers succeed in their title quest, it would be the team's ninth SCAC championship in the 12-year history of the conference.

The TU Tigers received eight of ten possible first-place votes. DePauw University and Southwestern University each collected one first-place vote.

Trinity, led by 17th-year head coach Julie Jenkins, finished the 2001 campaign at 35-5. The Tigers, playing in their 10th-straight NCAA tournament, advanced to the national quarterfinals before losing 3-1 to Juniata. Trinity was the national runner-up in 1999.
