**TRINITY MEN DEFEAT SOUTHWESTERN FOR SCAC CROWN;  
OPEN NCAA PLAY WEDNESDAY AT TEXAS LUTHERAN**

**SAN ANTONIO, Texas** - The Trinity men's soccer team will be traveling to Seguin to take on Texas Lutheran University in the first round of the NCAA playoffs.

The Tigers wrapped up the regular season with a 4-2 victory over Southwestern on Saturday to clinch the program's sixth conference championship and fifth in the last seven years.

Trinity, which is the top-ranked team in the nation according to the latest NSCAA rankings, will play at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 13. Trinity and Texas Lutheran (14-3-2) played to a 1-1 tie earlier this season. A win on Wednesday would send the Tigers to a West Region semifinal match-up with Colorado College (15-5-1) on Saturday at University of Redlands in Redlands, Calif.

The Tigers earned the SCAC's automatic bid to the NCAA playoffs by winning the conference championship with a record of 8-0-1 in league play. Overall, Trinity has compiled a record of 16-0-2 this season.

Trinity has been to the NCAA playoffs six of the last seven years and reached the national quarterfinals in consecutive years (1998 and 1999).
