DEPAUW UNIVERSITY MEN DOMINATE; WIN SECOND-CONSECUTIVE CROSS COUNTRY TITLE WITH RECORD-BREAKING SCORE

Danville, Ky. -- DePauw University lived up to its billing as the 15th-ranked team in the nation, finishing with a SCAC-record team score of 16 to win the men's title in dominating fashion at the 2001 SCAC Cross Country Championships at Centre College. It was the second-consecutive conference championship for the DePauw men.

The Tigers were led by two-time SCAC Runner-of-the-Year, senior Eric Fruth, who won with a time of 26:06.32 – the second fastest time ever at the conference championships. The Tigers had five of the top six finishers, including the first four of Fruth, Simon Flory (26:14), Torrey Teats (26:32) and Matt DeLeon (26:37). In all, seven DePauw runners finished in the top 14 and made the All-SCAC team.

Behind a fifth-place finish by Brian McCarthy, Rhodes College finished second. The host school Centre narrowly edged Trinity University for third place.
